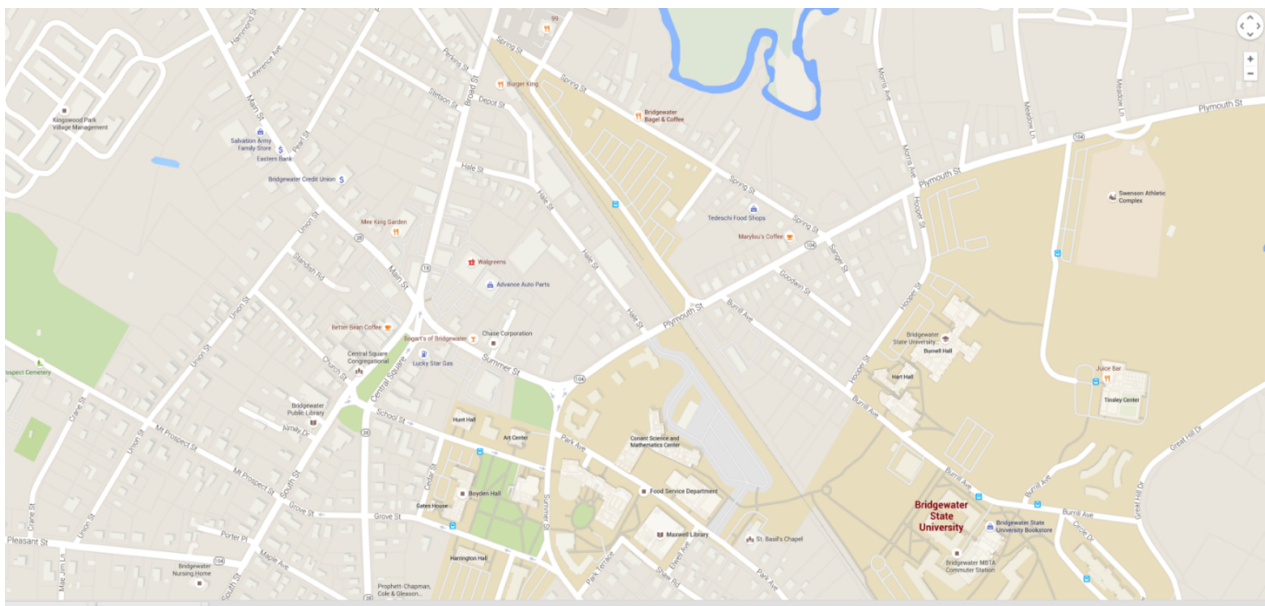
Tag a Sig — Monday, April 25, 2016

- Teams will be awarded 10 points for every Sigma Chi's shirt they write their team's name on. Find them walking around campus!
 - 5 additional points will be awarded if one (or more) team members take a selfie with the brother and posts it to Facebook **with the following tags:** #HuntsmanOlympics & #SigmaChi
- **You cannot write your team's name on a brother's shirt who is on your own team.**
- Make sure you write your team name legibly on each shirt. Each brother will submit the names of the teams they were tagged by at the end of the day for calculating points.
- Brothers tagged after midnight shall not be counted.

Scavenger Hunt — Monday, April 25, 2016

- Easter eggs containing stories of cancer survivors touched by the Huntsman Cancer Institute will be hidden across Bridgewater. Follow the clues to find the eggs.
- Each team may only take **one** egg from each location. Remove the story from the egg and hold onto it. At the end of the day, put all the stories your team collected together in an envelope or similar safe place. Turn them in at the beginning of the dodgeball tournament the following day.
- 10 points will be awarded for each unique story collected. Multiple copies of the same story—meaning multiple eggs were taken from the same location—will result in a penalty of receiving no points for that story.



Rules of Engagement

Each team must follow the clues around the local Bridgewater area to find Easter eggs. Each egg contains a survivor story about how the Huntsman Cancer Institute saved their life. There are a total of nine different locations where the eggs are hidden. Each clue is a hint for a street name. The team with the most eggs to turned in first wins, followed by two runner ups.

*If you take more than one egg from a single location you will be penalized. This is to ensure all teams can equally compete against each other.

Clue 1: This street is only around for three hot months

Clue 2: Burr gets very ill on this avenue

Clue 3: You could put this place on your pancakes

Clue 4: At this place everyone is together

Clue 5: This is the Street of Education

Clue 6: All Hail the King

Clue 7: On this street you can broaden your horizons

Clue 8: You can journey to this street and confess your sins

Buyback Dodgeball — Tuesday, April 26, 2016

- 10 participation points will be provided for each team member who shows up, to a maximum of 4 (all your players are encouraged to attend, but to keep it fair for teams of only four, additional members won't be awarded points for just showing up)
- Teams will compete in a bracketed dodgeball tournament. Each player will have **five** opportunities to buy back into each match they participate in for \$1 each. A Sigma Chi will be present at the sidelines to collect each donation to buy back in.
- *First Place: 50 points, Second Place: 25 points, Third Place: 10 points*

Bake Off — Wednesday, April 27, 2016

- Each team will be provided with a cake pan and batter at the conclusion of the dodgeball tournament on Tuesday. Each team will then bake a cake, using any additional ingredients as they see fit.
- Each team must deliver their cake to Trivia Night at 6 PM on Wednesday, April 27 for judging. The cakes will be judged while Trivia Night occurs.
- *First Place: 50 points, Second Place: 25 points, Third Place: 10 points*

Trivia Night — Wednesday, April 27, 2016

- 10 participation points will be provided for each team member who shows up, to a maximum of 4 (all your players are encouraged to attend, but to keep it fair for teams of only four, additional members won't be awarded points for just showing up)
- *First Place: 50 points, Second Place: 25 points, Third Place: 10 points*

Wing Eating Contest — Thursday, April 28, 2016

- 10 participation points will be provided for each team member who shows up, to a maximum of 4 (all your players are encouraged to attend, but to keep it fair for teams of only four, additional members won't be awarded points for just showing up)
- *First Place: 50 points, Second Place: 25 points, Third Place: 10 points*

Car Smash — Friday, April 29

- 10 participation points will be provided for each team member who shows up, to a maximum of 4 (all your players are encouraged to attend, but to keep it fair for teams of only four, additional members won't be awarded points for just showing up)
- We will be raffling off the opportunity to smash the windows. You can buy raffle tickets for each window at every event Tuesday-Friday. The raffle drawing will occur at 12:30 PM. You must be present at 12:30 PM to win and be able to smash the windows.
